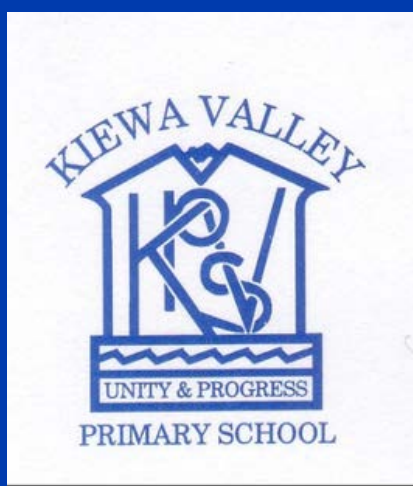

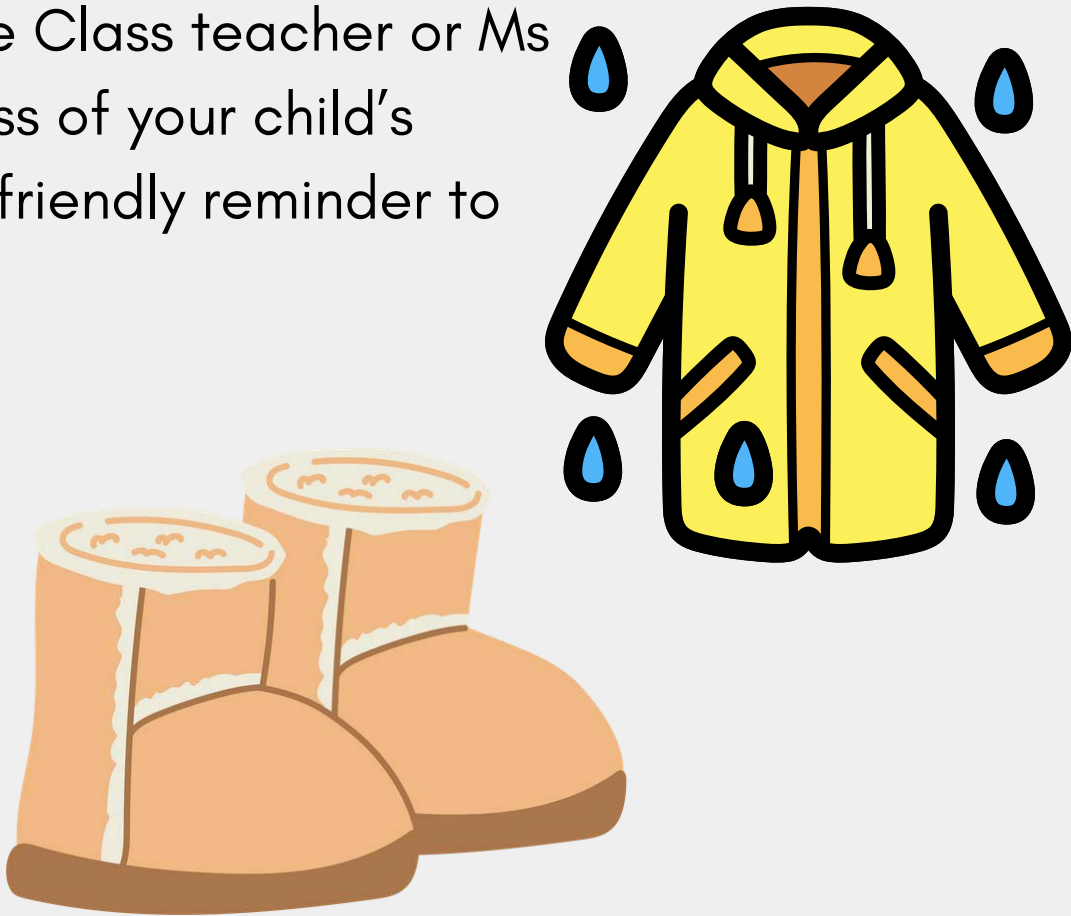


HOLIDAYS:

For a number of years now, Kiewa Valley Primary School students have participated in the Australian Mathematics Competition. This is an optional online event for students in Grade 3-6. Every year, our numbers grow with students continuing to demonstrate a growth mindset to take on new challenges.

Entry is \$9.30 per student and the competition happens in early August. It's online, for 1 hour, during school time. The competition consists of 30 problem solving questions.

There are no prizes, but all students recieve a certificate and a copy of thier results.

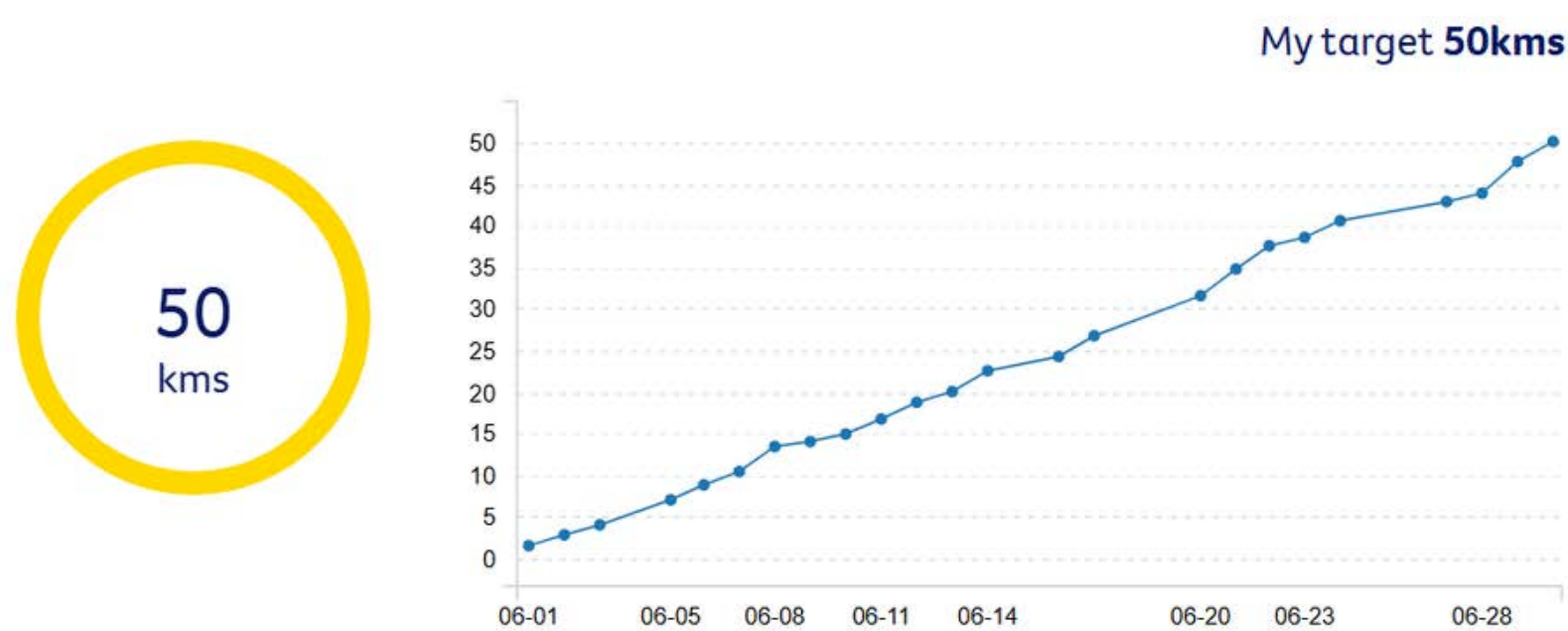
DAISY NEWS

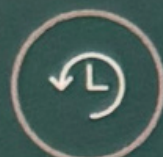

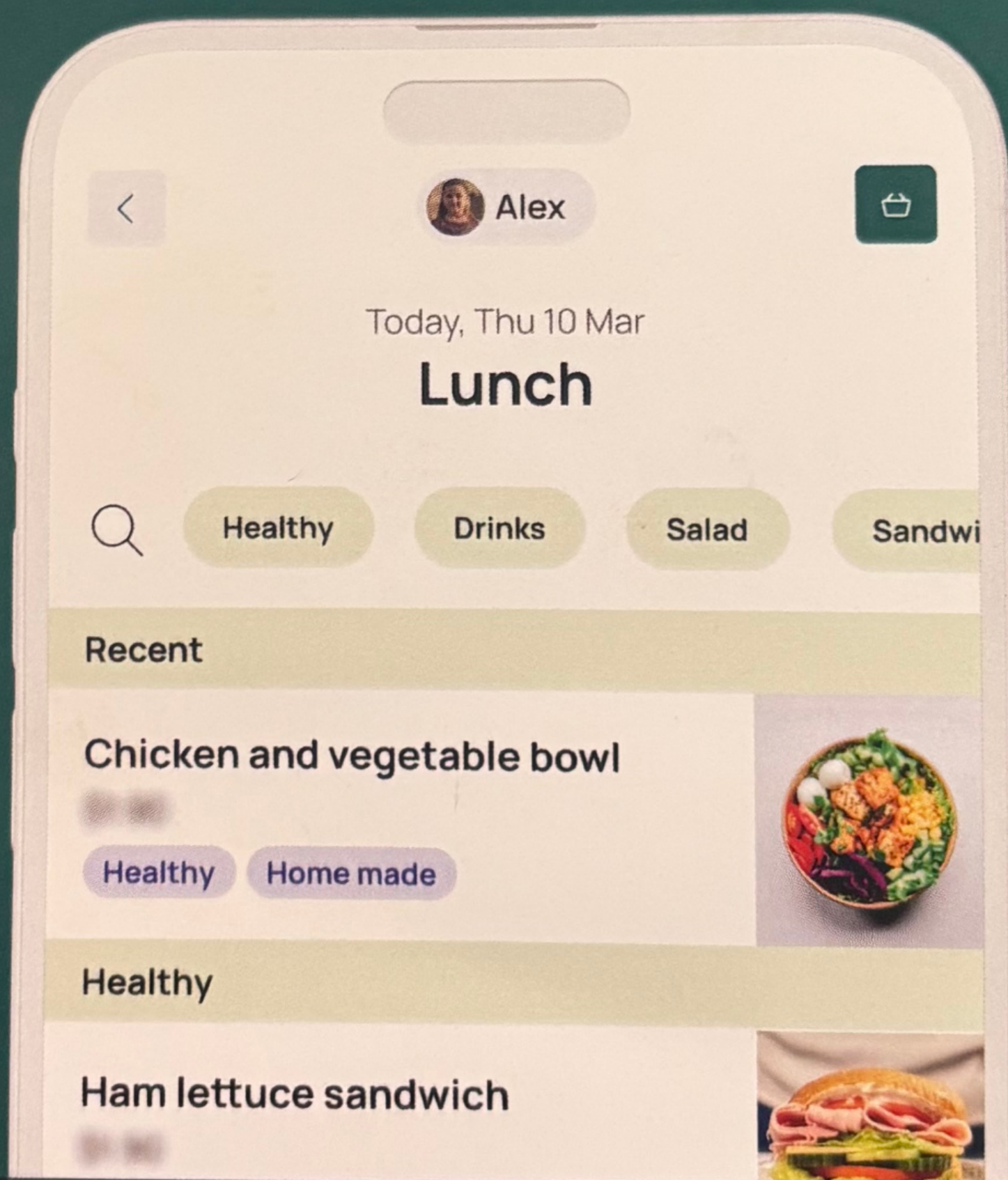

We'd like to apologise for any inconvenience this change may cause, and thank you for your understanding.

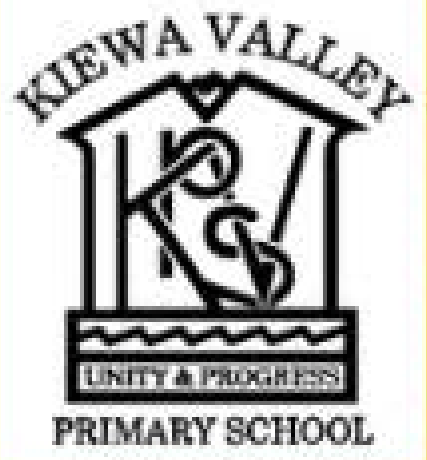
