#### PRINCIPAL UPDATE:

#### SUPERVISION HOURS FOR STUDENTS

Our school <u>provides supervision of students from 8.35am until 3.45pm daily.</u> We run an OUTSIDE HOURS SCHOOL CARE program from 7am to 6pm daily. If you require your child to be supervised prior to 8.35am and after 3.45pm please contact OHSC and book your child into this service. No student should be onsite outside these times. This past week some students have been riding, walking or being dropped off for school from 8am without any knowledge of staff or communication from parents and carers. Please make sure you are following the school hours or utilising the school services provided to ensure your child/ren are safe.




We will also be running our working bee during this event. If you would like to participate bring along some gardening gloves. We will be weeding, mulching, preparing the beds and planting new plants.
